



In accordance with the Texas Government guidelines and the Kalpana issued by the Assistant Diocesan Metropolitan, No/30 dated May 29, we will be opening our parish for regular Sunday services starting Sunday, June 7 2020.

**Please note, if you are above 65 years of age or having other underlying health issues it is advised that you stay home and follow the CDC guidelines. Also, if you are experiencing any fever, coughing or any symptoms of sickness or have been exposed to anyone with those symptoms, please refrain from attending.**

**If you are planning to attend please follow the below listed guidelines**

1. Gates will be closed all times, please bring your gate cards to open the gate.
2. Make sure to sanitize your hands prior to entering the Church.
3. Wearing face mask inside the church is MANDATORY to protect you and others. Please follow this strictly.
4. Please maintain social distancing when inside the church. At all times keep minimum 6ft distance from all around you.
5. There can ONLY be five altar assistants allowed at one time in the altar and all the rest can stand below. All altar assistants should wear a mask at all times and maintain safe distance.
6. If you use any equipment (mic, books etc.), cover your face at all times while using this equipment and refrain from touching your face until you have properly sanitized your hands.
7. All microphones need to be left alone in the stands and they should not be removed from the stands.
8. Also, please note as per the Kalpana by HH there will not be any absolution with hands on the head, no kiss of peace during the service, and kaimuth at the end. Also, please refrain from kissing anything inside the sanctuary or the hands of the priest as per the Kalpana.
9. Families with very small children are also encouraged NOT to attend the service with them as it is unsafe for them since they have the habit of touching multiple surfaces.
10. The Auditorium will not be open, and no coffee or refreshments will be served. Please sanitize your hands upon exit and leave the facility immediately after the Qurbana is finished, do not stay and socialize.
11. After you submit your form, you will be notified through WhatsApp by Saturday evening in advance, if you made the first 50 on the list. ONLY those on the published list can attend.
